1 Maths

We will continue to carefully count objects and count the children at Nursery every day! We will begin to form our numerals 1 – 5 by learning rhymes and we will match these numerals to amounts. We will start to explore number composition using practical resources e.g. we can make 4 using 2 and 2 or 3 and 1.



1 Communication and Language

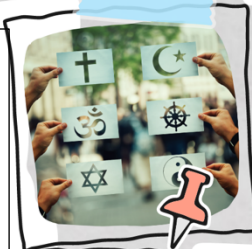
We will be encouraged to have conversations with one another, ask questions and listen to answers. We will begin to pay attention to more than one thing at a time.

3 Topic

In our 'Puddles and Rainbows' topic we will look at the change in weather, waterproof materials and colours within a rainbow. We will also cover 'Dangerous Dinosaurs' where we will look at the different types of dinosaurs that existed, what they ate and where they lived.

4 RE / PSED

We will think about Lent and how people put crosses in Easter gardens to remember Jesus. We will also explore Eid and make Eid cards for our friends. We will practise our magical manners and think about why they are important. We will try our best to have a go and keep trying.



5 Phonics

We will be encouraged to notice words that have the same letter sound at the start and we will listen to words and think about the initial sound. We will clap the syllables that are in words, particularly our names. We will try and follow text when reading stories focusing on how we read print from left to right.

Expressive Art and Design

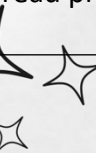
