1 Communication and Language

We will continue to have conversations with one another, ask questions and listen to answers. We will begin to organise ourselves through talk and recall a growing number of stories.



3 Topic

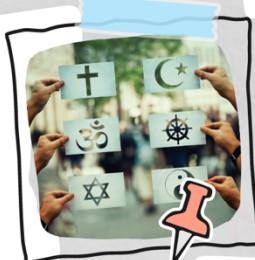
In our 'Big Wide World' topic we will look at the world around us – different countries, languages, climates and cultures. We will explore a range of vehicles and how we might travel to different places. We will look at different habitats around the world and think carefully about how some are being damaged!

2 Maths

We will revisit shape and repeating patterns with an element of problem solving. We will count daily and sing a range of number songs. We will focus on matching numerals to amounts of objects and begin to explore the composition of number e.g. two and two makes four.

4 RE / PSED

We will celebrate Saint Barnabas Day by visiting church and being encouragers just like him! We will be supported to talk about feelings and solve problems independently and appropriately.



5 Phonics

We will continue to orally blend words daily, "t-i-n, tin" with a focus on the sounds s, a, t, p, i and n. We will play musical instruments thinking about rhythm and body percussion. Our listening ears will help us identify a range of environmental sounds!

We will continue to sing songs and rhymes daily! We will be given the opportunity to retell stories with props and small world. We will use a range of materials and techniques to create artwork.



7 Physical Development

We are practising our dressing skills, particularly taking off and putting on our jumpers and cardigans when we feel hot or cold. We will be practising for and taking part in Nursery Sports Day. We will also take part in team games and work together to achieve a common goal.
