School starts at 8.45am.



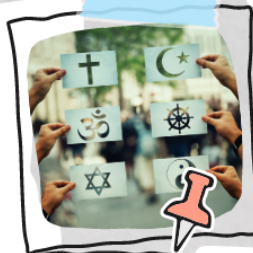
2 Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about position and direction, developing our understanding of movement, turns and describing positions. We will also consolidate our learning on fractions, including finding fractions of amounts using a range of different methods. In addition, we will explore statistics by interpreting and presenting data, while continuing to practise and strengthen our arithmetic skills throughout the term.



4 RE

This half term in RE, we will be studying Islam with a focus on mercy, and answering the question, how do some Muslims show Allah is compassionate and merciful?



6 Geog/Hist

In Geography we are learning about fieldwork and improving our map skills within our local area.



KEEPING IN TOUCH

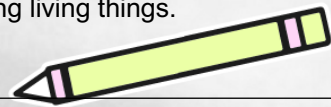


1 English

We will start this term by writing a recount of our trip to the beach applying all the grammar techniques that we have learnt. We will also be learning to write a character description for the book we have been reading 'Fantastic Mr fox'. We will focus on expanding our vocabulary, improving sentence structure, and applying grammar, punctuation, and spelling accurately through exploring poetry. We will learn how to plan, draft, edit, and publish our work, helping us to become confident and imaginative writers.

3 Science

In Science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will explore a variety of habitats and discover how plants and animals are suited to the environments in which they live. We will investigate food chains, identify sources of food, and learn about the importance of different habitats in supporting living things.



5 Computing

In our computing unit this term, we will be looking at programming. We will be programming robot algorithms and will be introducing the children to quizzes and how to make them.



7 PE

In PE we will be completing a mix of fitness and striking and fielding lessons. Don't forget to bring your PE kits in everyday!

8 Music

In music, we will be learning to sing and sign the song 'here comes the sun'. We'll learn about elements of control in music, such as duration, tempo, texture, rhythm and dynamics.



9 PSHE

In PSHE we be learning techniques to be able work with everyone in our class. We will be learning about what our bodies and minds need to keep healthy. We will be learning about water safety and sun safety.



10 Art

This term we will be working with our artist in residence Sue Guthrie. Sue brings a wealth of knowledge and creativity. Sue will lead guided drawing and painting lessons.



11 DT

This term in DT we will be studying food and nutrition, and answering the question how healthy is your food? Pupils will learn how foods that are pre-made and processed can often be unhealthy.
